Guided Old Town Tour & Viktualienmarkt



A cosmopolitan city with heart

Munich's cityscape is characterized by centuries-old buildings and numerous museums. On a guided tour of the old town, you will discover the most beautiful places and learn many interesting stories. It all began at Marienplatz, the former market square and most central point of Munich. Here, the search for traces of Munich's history begins, from its origins as a market on the old salt road to the metropolis it is today. But why are there two town halls, and why does the New Town Hall look older than the Old Town Hall? The oldest church in the city, St. Peter's on Petersbergl, was almost completely destroyed during World War II, but was rebuilt with the help of a special idea. But what does the traffic news on Bayern 3 have to do with it? In the Old Court, the first residence of the Wittelsbach family, you will learn how the Monkey Tower got its name. And what is the story behind the origins of the Theatine Church? There is much to discover...

The proof of the pudding is in the eating

As part of a Viktualienmarkt tasting tour, delicious delicacies are offered at lunchtime at various market stalls, accompanied by historical and current background information. A multitude of culinary discoveries and delights make this walk through Germany's largest open-air market, covering 22,000 m², an experience for all the senses. Countless stories during the tour take you through the history of the market to the present day: How did the Viktualienmarkt come into being? Since when has the dance of the market women existed? Where do the market people take their goods in the evening? How do you get a stall and how much do the stall owners have to pay to the city?

The palace and park complex, with their combination of architecture and garden design, are a total work of art of European significance. Famous attractions include the Gallery of Beauties, featuring the king's mistress Lola Montez, and the world-renowned Nymphenburg porcelain collection. Nymphenburg Palace takes visitors into the world of kings and princesses. It was not only the summer residence, but also a favorite castle of the Wittelsbach family. The castle and park complex, with its combination of architecture and garden design, is a total work of art of European significance. At court with the maid - a very special kind of tour

The talkative chambermaid takes advantage of her mistress's absence to give you a private tour and reveal first-hand information. The maid first leads you to the Stone Hall, the castle's banquet hall. This is where the mistress indulges in lavish celebrations. The maid proudly explains the elaborate ceiling fresco, which pays homage to the nymph Flora, who became a goddess. In the master's chambers, there are some curious portraits to admire, about which the maid has much to say. The Electress Marie Amalie, for example, was a gifted huntress, but she wore far too much white lead makeup. The bitter consequence was terrible scars and wrinkles. The maid also has plenty to say about the young Maria Leopoldine. The 17-year-old Archduchess of Austria-Este was married to the 70-year-old Elector of Munich, Karl Theodor. Instead of blessing her husband with children, however, she amused herself with much younger lovers. What a scandal! The finest tapestries, screens, and chinoiserie, elegant luxury furniture, elaborate stucco work, and expensive paintings line the rest of the way through the palace. In the bedchamber of the gracious Queen Caroline, the maid admires her mistress's elegant bed made of exotic mahogany wood and covered with emerald green linen. It was in this venerable bed that Ludwig II, the legendary fairy-tale king, first saw the light of day.

Day trip to Lake Tegernsee

The picturesque mountains, the scenic landscape of the Alpine foothills, and Bavarian hospitality...

The most pleasant way to explore the region is from the water with a relaxing trip on Lake Tegernsee, passing by the most picturesque places. The Wallberg (1,722 m), Munich's local mountain, is one of the most beautiful sights on Lake Tegernsee and dominates the view of the Tegernsee Valley from afar. The summit can be easily reached by the Wallbergbahn cable car, from where visitors can enjoy a breathtaking view of the entire valley and the mountains to the south, all the way to the Austrian border. From the mountain station, it is a good 100 meters of elevation gain to the summit, which can be covered in about half an hour.
